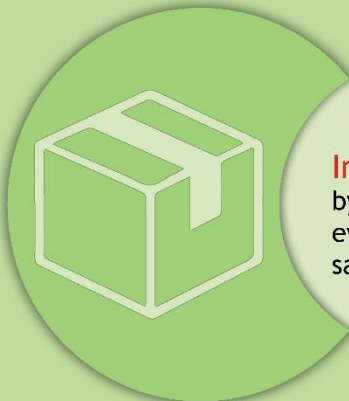


Grants & Funding

BBC Children in Need - Projects and organisations working with children and young people can apply to have their core costs funded throughout the cost-of-living crisis. This can include management, administration, office costs or any expenses required to keep the organization running.

National Lottery Community Fund, Wales - Has £2 million available to help organisations and the communities they serve to help with the Cost-of-living Crisis in Wales.
