#### Our impact on the environment



For every tonne of surplus food redistributed, we prevent the waste of 2 tonnes of CO2e emissions and 2.66 million litres of water.

In 2023/24, we prevented the waste of over **106,000 tonnes of CO2e emissions and 141 billion litres of water** associated with producing, storing and transporting surplus food and drink.

#### The need for our work

As of January 2024, an estimated 11 million people (8 million adults and 3 million children) are facing food insecurity, this represents nearly **one 1 in 7 people in the UK (including 3 million children)** can't afford enough healthy food.
