Main purpose of this role

FareShare Midlands is looking to recruit a talented and experienced individual to help deliver our fundraising strategy. This is an exciting time to join FareShare Midlands as we develop and expand our operations across the East and West Midlands and look to grow our fantastic portfolio of trust, grant and foundations supporters, as well as corporate partners and community supporters.

We are looking for someone ambitious who wants to take a lead on the creation, submission and management of a portfolio of trust and grant applications in order to achieve financial targets in line with our growth plans. If you have demonstrable experience in securing income from trusts, foundations and grants, as well as relationship building and stewardship of donors, this role is for you.

About FareShare Midlands

FareShare Midlands is the region's largest food redistribution charity fighting food poverty by tackling food waste. An independent charity, we work in partnership with FareShare UK to access and receive food that is surplus to requirements from retailers and manufacturers and engage many volunteers to help redistribute this to local charities and community groups that provide meals to vulnerable people including families and individuals who are homeless, unemployed, socially isolated or recovering from addiction.

FareShare Midlands supports over 400 local charities and community groups. In the last twelve months we redistributed over 2,700 tonnes of food, helping to create 6.4 million meals and feed 35,000 people each week.

Account Management and Donor Care

- Manage a portfolio of trust, foundation and grant supporters to cultivate strong, long-lasting partnerships
- Inspire and motivate funders through creating a portfolio of materials that demonstrate impact
- In conjunction with the development team, support the management of corporate partnerships/foundations including meeting with stakeholders, stewardship and impact reporting
- Manage income and expenditure of project budgets communicating with both internal and external stakeholders
- Manage and steward funders in accordance with the Fundraising Code of Practice and ensure high standards of supporter care are maintained at all times
- Work closely with the FareShare UK fundraising team to maximise funding opportunities and share learning
- Ensure funder interaction points (telephone, post, email) adhere to the highest standards
- Undertake any other duties that may reasonably be required from time to time

- Maintain accurate financial records and budgets for all partners
