## **About the Tesco Food Collection**

Tesco is running a special Food Collection this summer to support FareShare and the Trussell Trust, taking place in Tesco Extra and Superstores from 15-17 July and from 12 July until 28 August in all Tesco Express stores.

The collection will support FareShare in delivering vital food supplies to frontline organisations providing a lifeline to those most affected by the coronavirus pandemic.

Virtual Volunteers can pledge their support for FareShare in a number of ways - every small action can have a big impact! Here are just some of the ways you can support us:

## **About FareShare**

FareShare is the UK's largest food redistribution charity. We take food from the food industry that can't be sold in shops, either because of packaging errors or a short shelf life, and we redistribute it through a network of 11,000 frontline organisations. We support groups such as homeless hostels, school breakfast clubs, domestic violence refuges, older people's lunch clubs, food banks and hospices. FareShare provides enough food to create more than a million meals for vulnerable people every week.

Food poverty is a big issue in the UK - 1 in 8 people in the UK currently struggle to afford to eat and, of that figure, 1 in 4 of those in the UK affected by food poverty children. 1 in 10 people miss meals to pay their bills.

Since the beginning of the coronavirus crisis:

- 1.5 million people have gone a day without eating
- 8 million adults have experienced food insecurity





- More than 1.5 million people in households with children are unable to access food for economic reasons
- The number of adults who are food insecure in Britain is estimated to have quadrupled

The Tesco Food Collection brings in a huge amount of much needed, long-life food to the FareShare network. It is a great source of stock and allows us to top up food donations to our charities with ambient stock that lasts much longer than fresh items.

Donations from this Food Collection are even more vital as many families face financial strain over the school holidays as children do not receive free school meals during this time.

At FareShare, we have seen a significant increase in demand throughout the pandemic:

- The number of charities applying to receive food from FareShare has more than tripled
- We're also tripling the amount of food we're getting out to frontline charities
- More than 1,000 new charities have been signed up to get food since the start of the pandemic
- Ambient food has been the most in demand food for all charities across FareShare
  - Ambient stock levels are now critically low
  - As a result, we're having to reduce the amount of ambient food going to all charities
